DETAILS OF ACTIVITIES

FINANCIAL YEAR 2013 – 14

1. Animal Birth Control (ABC) and Anti Rabies Vaccination(ARV):

The Trust has sterilized about 1940 dogs during the year and administered ARV to about 3000 dogs. Further, in July, 2013, the Trust has joined hands with World Wide Veterinary Service India on Project Mission Rabies and conducted a massive anti-rabies vaccination camp for two weeks and vaccinated about 3350 dogs across Coimbatore.

2. Adoption Camps:

The Trust has got over 500 animals adopted through shelter and camps held across Coimbatore.

3. Animal Rescues:

The Trust has rescued and treated about 510 animals during the year.

4. Public Awareness Camps:

As part of educating public on humane treatment of animals as well as hygienic maintenance of surroundings and prevent unwanted stray-dog breeding, the Trust has conducted the following camps:

- i) **On 1st April, 2013** the Trust has organized Rabies awareness cum vaccination drive.
- ii) **On 17th April, 2013** an Awareness camp session was conducted at Sree Krishna Institute of Management.
- iii) **On 10th July, 2013** an Awareness program for Mission Rabies was conducted in Coimbatore.
- iv) **On 14th August, 2013** the Trust has conducted an Activities Awareness Stall and Donation Drive to create awareness about the projects of the Trust to launch an Ambulance for helping animals during emergency – with a duty doctor and a driver on call anytime. A stall was put up to CONSUMEX (Coimbatore Consumer Products Distributors Association Exhibition), an annual event held at Suguna Kalyana Mandapam, Coimbatore.
- v) **On 28th September, 2013** the Trust has organized a one-day camp to create awareness and free vaccination for companion animals.
- vi) **On 5th & 6th October, 2013** on the occasion of Joy of Giving Week, the Trust has put up a stall for an event organized by Rotary Coimbatore Central at Kikani School Grounds to create public awareness.
- vii) **On 24th, 25th & 26th February, 2014** as part of the World Spay Day, 60 dogs were sterilized at the Seeranaickenpalayam Shelter.
