ANNUAL REPORT 2018 – 2019

S. No	Activity	Description
APRIL 2018		
1	Summary	We have treated 314 animals as out-patients, administered Anti-Rabies Vaccination to 148 animals and Multi-Component Vaccine to 83 animals. We rescued 75 animals this month and also found homes for 23 pups & 2 dogs. We have performed Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgery on 75 animals. Our Education & Awareness team covered 2100 people through different campaigns.
2	12th Anniversary of HAS - 06-04-18	In the event of our 12th Anniversary of HAS, we had a small get together at our shelter and celebrated the occasion with our dear ones. We have rescued, rehabilitated and given treatments for more than 45000 in these years and it was indeed a proud moment of reflection.
3	Education & Awareness Program 02-04-18, 08-04-18, 14-04-18, 15-04-18, 19-04-18, 22-04-18, 25-04-18, 27-04-18	Our Humane education team visited 4 schools for humane education program and conducted awareness in two communities. A total of 2100 people attended our sessions, creating a milestone in our outreach activities. Two groups of school students also visited our shelter for their field trip. They were taken on a short tour around our shelter and was explained about ABC (Animal Birth Control) and ARV (Anti Rabies Vaccine).
May 2018		
4	Summary	We have treated 341 animals as out-patients, administered Anti-Rabies Vaccination to 102 animals and Multi-Component Vaccine to 105 animals. We rescued 80 animals this month and also found homes for 6 pups, 3 dogs & 1 kitten . We have performed Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgery on 49 animals. Our Education & Awareness team covered 750 people through different campaigns.
5	Education & Awareness Program 06-05-18, 12-05-18, 13-05-18, 20-05-18, 29-05-18, 30-05-18.	<p>We had two outreach sessions in public places. We used the opportunity to raise awareness about animal agriculture and cruelties about dairy industries. Our team was present at Summer night market and raised awareness about HAS and its activities. We also used the opportunity to raise funds for our shelter animals. We were able to reach more than 750 people in our awareness sessions this month.</p> <p>The vegan Potluck of the month was hosted by one of our long term volunteer, where 15 people participated in the potluck.</p>
JUNE 2018		
6	Summary	We have treated 457 animals as out-patients, administered Anti-Rabies Vaccination to 148 animals and Multi-Component Vaccine to 86 animals. We rescued 113 animals this month and also found homes for 25 pups, 6 dogs & 5 kittens . We have performed Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgery on 68 animals. Our Education & Awareness team covered 1000 people through different campaigns.
7	Education & Awareness Program 23-06-18, 24-06-18, 25-06-18, 28-06-18	<p>Our Humane education team visited 2 schools and also conducted awareness program in a public event this month. We were able to spread the word about HAS and also raise awareness about Rabies to over 1000 people through our campaigns.</p> <p>Our vegan potluck for June was fun with a lot of people and lots of food. We had 25 people attending the potluck this month.</p>
JULY 2018		
8	Summary	We have treated 323 animals as out-patients, administered Anti-Rabies Vaccination to 143 animals and Multi-Component Vaccine to 107 animals. We rescued 84 animals this month and also found homes for 28 pups, 5 dogs & 8 kittens. We have performed Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgery on 93 animals. Our Education & Awareness team covered 5111 people through different campaigns.
9	Education & Awareness Program 04-07-18, 06-07-18, 10-07-18, 13-07-18, 20-07-18, 23-07-18, 26-07-18, 29-07-18	This month was very positive in terms of our humane education and awareness programs as we were able to raise awareness to over 5111 people breaking our own previous record. We covered 6 schools, 1 college in our outreach activities this month. We also had 100 students visiting our shelter from Anan kids academy for their field visit. They were educated about five freedoms of animal welfare and also about caring for community animals.

		July's potluck was fun with many new faces from local as well as volunteers from foreign countries. Our lunch started with a prayer and ended with a group photo as usual. After lunch everyone introduced themselves and shared their experiences about animal cruelty and why they became vegan.
AUGUST 2018		
10	Summary	We have treated 330 animals as out-patients, administered Anti-Rabies Vaccination to 202 animals and Multi-Component Vaccine to 92 animals. We rescued 93 animals this month and also found homes for 17 pups, 1 dog & 4 kittens. We have performed Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgery on 96 animals. Our Education & Awareness team covered 1900 people through different campaigns.
11	Musical Evening - 07-08-2018	Dr. Joanne Kong and SatvikVegan ShankarNarayan visited coimbatore for the musical evening event. Joanne Kong commenced her session by playing a few classical pieces. She also gave a small talk about veganism and its benefits.
12	Siblings with paws event - 25-08-18	We celebrated siblings with paws event at our shelter in the eve of Raksh Bandhan. Several volunteers visited our shelter with gifts to our pooches. They also spent time, taking them out for walks and socializing them.
13	Education & Awareness Program 01-08-18, 07-08-18, 10-08-18, 11-08-18, 18-08-18, 19-08-18, 21-08-18	Our team visited Sri Krishna college for inaugurating their Nature club. We used the opportunity to raise awareness about HAS and its activities. Our team conducted awareness programs in 2 schools and in one public gathering covering nearly 1900 people. Students from PSG college helped us raise awareness about Rabies in nearby communities of which was followed by a Anti-rabies vaccination drive.
SEPTEMBER 2018		
14	Summary	We have treated 335 animals as out-patients, administered Anti-Rabies Vaccination to 337 animals and Multi-Component Vaccine to 117 animals. We rescued 100 animals this month and also found homes for 23 pups, 6 dog & 1 kitten. We have performed Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgery on 55 animals. Our Education & Awareness team covered 1815 people through different campaigns.
15	Eye Donation awareness rally - 02-09-18	Team members of Humane Animal Society (Coimbatore) happily obliged to take part in the Eye donation awareness rally organized by Coimbatore society of ophthalmic surgeons. Nearly 15 of our shelter dogs participated in the rally, which got a lot of attention from the start. Our dogs were provided with bandannas which had the message for the day "SUPPORT EYE DONATION". Our pooches carried the message with style and were looking super awesome.
16	World Rabies day - 28-09-18	Team HAS conducted Anti-Rabies Vaccination (ARV) drive in the areas of Tankpet Street, Nethaji Nagar, Karumalai Chettipalyam, MGR Nagar, Sugarcane road and Dr. Radhakrishnan road. We vaccinated over 250 dogs in a span of two days.
17	Education & Awareness Program 04-09-18, 08-09-18, 12-08-18, 14-09-18, 15-09-18, 16-09-18, 17-08-18, 24-09-18, 26-09-18	<p>Our Humane Education team visited 3 schools and 4 colleges this month. We spoke to a total of 1815 people raising awareness about HAS, Veganism and Rabies. We also two groups of college and school students visiting our shelter this month to learn more about wo.rk</p> <p>A group of 12 children from CS academy visited our shelter. The kids were taken around to make them familiar with the place. They got to play with the dogs in the dog run area.</p> <p>Our vegan potluck for Spetember was fun with a lot of people and lots of food. We had 28 people attending the potluck this month.</p> <p>Team HAS along with a few amazing volunteers - students of Sankara college of Arts and Science campaigned in the nearby areas to raise awareness about the deadly disease of Rabies and how easy it is to prevent that. So effective was the campaign that several people came forward to confine community dogs inside their compound for us to vaccinate them easily.</p>

18	Summary	We have treated 339 animals as out-patients, administered Anti-Rabies Vaccination to 147 animals and Multi-Component Vaccine to 121 animals. We rescued 74 animals this month and also found homes for 19 pups, 2 dogs. We have performed Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgery on 79 animals. Our Education & Awareness team covered 2086 people through different campaigns.

Several people attended our potluck and also agreed to show support for conducting an Save Avni rally for the tigress.</p>
NOVEMBER 2018		
20	Summary	We have treated 339 animals as out-patients, administered Anti-Rabies Vaccination to 147 animals and Multi-Component Vaccine to 121 animals. We rescued 74 animals this month and also found homes for 19 pups, 2 dogs. We have performed Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgery on 79 animals. Our Education & Awareness team covered 2086 people through different campaigns.
21	Volunteering event - 04-11-18	A group of 30 volunteers visited HAS and helped us with various tasks. They helped us to paint our shelter/sanctuary gates and with the maintenance tasks of the shelter.
22	Peace march for Avni, the tigress - 11-11-18	More than 50 people participated in the peace march against killing of Avni held in Race course.
23	Education & Awareness Program 12-11-18, 13-11-18, 16-11-18, 24-11-18, 26-11-18,	We were present at two different schools this month. A total of 2086 students and teachers attended our session. We used our ppt to explain the five freedoms of animal welfare and doge (dog behaviour and language).
		Our vegan potluck for September was fun with a lot of people and a special guest. We had 25 people attending the potluck this month.
		Mini Vasudevan (Founder trustee) and Heena Acharya (Humane Education Officer) represented Humane Animal Society (Coimbatore) attended IFA (India For Animals) a conference organised by FIAPO (Federation Of Indian Animal Protection Organisations). The conference was about meeting like minded people from various parts of the country
		We conducted Anti-rabies vaccination drives in several days of this month with the help of Vet and team from HIS along side of HAS team. We managed to vaccinate more than 300 dogs in these ARV drives.
DECEMBER 2018		
24	Summary	We have treated 509 animals as out-patients, administered Anti-Rabies Vaccination to 895 animals and Multi-Component Vaccine to 150 animals. We rescued 65 animals this month and also found homes for 19 pups, 2 dogs and 2 kittens. We have performed Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgery on 97 animals. Our Education & Awareness team covered 1690 people through different campaigns.
25	Anti-rabies vaccination drive - 14-12-18	The second phase of our mass Anti-Rabies Vaccination (ARV) drive concluded this month where we were able to vaccinate more than 1000 free-roaming, community and pet dogs in 5 wards of the west zone.
26	Wish tree event - 24-12-18	We celebrated Wish tree event at our shelter in the eve of Christmas. Several of our regular volunteers dropped in at our shelter with gifts for our pooches. Our pooches had a wonderful time spending time with them.
27	Education & Awareness Program 4-12-2018, 07-12-18, 08-12-18, 09-12-18, 15-12-18, 16-12-18, 26-12-18	Our team were present at two public events and two colleges this month raising awareness to over 1690 people in both the sessions. We displayed exciting HAS merchandise - our flagship products - T-shirts and Calendars. We also got the opportunity to talk to people about animal welfare and spread the word about HAS.
		Our Vegan Potluck for this month was a bit early and we are glad about it as activists from The Save Movement could join us. With a lot of chit chat and laughter, it was good Sunday afternoon. We hope to inspire more people to join us.

Our Education & Awareness team covered 4608 people through different campaigns.
