Apr-22		
1	Summary	We have treated 211 animals as out-patients. 200 Multi-Component Vaccine and 267 Anti-Rabies Vaccination was administered. We have rescued 27 animals in total this month. We were successful in finding permanent homes for 4 dogs, 18 pups and 9 kittens. We have also done Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgeries on 178 animals.
2	16 Years of HAS	For the past 16 years, HAS has been a major contributor to animal welfare by being a voice for the voiceless. With the immense support and co-ordination of the members, donors, corporate partners, volunteers, community caretakers and rescues, HAS has reached this milestone and it promises to continue its services.
3	Inaugurating the Humane Animal Hospital	Veteran Rescuer Dawn Willaim, General Manager of Rescues, Blue Cross India (Chennai) inaugurated the Humane Animal Hospital at Selvapuram to provide affordable and quality health care for pets. It was followed by an interactive session which imparted the importance of volunteering, need for laws and animal cruelty.
4	Go Glam- A Fundraiser Event	The Go-Glam event was held between 1st-3rd April, 2022 at Suguna Kalyana Mandapam. HAS in partner with @raindropsbyamishi created a stall selling homemade jewellery, keychains, fridge magnets, keychains etc. The proceeds from this event was solely spent towards meeting the shelter costs and needs.
5	Adopt-A-Thon- Pet Adoption Drive	Amazon Prime India and The Hindu organized a pet adoption drive to promote the film 'Oh My Dog' at Brookefields Mall on 23rd April, 2022. The event was a grand success wherein 18 adoptions in total including pups and kittens from 33 HAS-registered pets found their forever homes.
	Inauguration of Special Enclosure for Paralysed Dogs at HAS Sanctuary	Leaders from Bosch Global Software Solutions and Board Members of HAS inaugurated the Special Enclosure for Paralysed Dogs at HAS on the 1st April, 2022. Earlier a session on Human-Animal Bond, First-Aid and Street Animal Care was organised by HAS for the employees of Bosch.
May-22		
1	Summary	We have treated a total of 381 animals as out-patients. 75 Multi-Component Vaccine and 344 Anti-Rabies Vaccination was administered. Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgeries were performed on 218 animals. We had rescued 36 dogs and 9 pups and triumphed in finding forever homes for 17 of them.
2	DonateKart Campaign	HAS featured in DoanteKart, a crowd funding campaign which enabled donors from all over the world to extend their support to NGOs. HAS was a part of this campaign and it received overwhelming response from the donors who provided monetary support to meet the expenses incurred at HAS for food, medication and construction material.
3	Be Indie Proud' Sponsorship by Pedigree	Pedigree had launched the global campaign 'Be Indie Proud'. HAS was one amongst the NGOs selected for this campaign and free Pedigree's Adoption Starter Kits were presented to all the bighearted Indie dog adopters. This campaign persisted the significance of adopting a pet instead of buying one.
4	Animal Liberation March	Our founder Dr. Mini Vasudevan representing HAS and being a voice of the animals at HAS, participated in the Animal Liberation March India at Mumbai on the 28th of March, 2022. The objective of this campaign was to bring to light the cruelty faced by animals in the dairy and meat industry. It is high time that people recognize and realise the rights of animals and let them lead a peaceful life on Mother Earth.
5	Bosch Volunteer Visit	The CSR programme of Bosch in collaboration with HAS provided a platform for 20 employees of Bosch to volunteer at HAS. The volunteers were given shelter orientation followed by session on 'Basics of Animals Handling and First Aid'. The volunteers spent quality time with our four-legged friends by grooming them, taking them for walks and pampering the physically challenged ones.

1	Summary	We have treated a total of 302 animals as out-patients. 53 Multi-Component Vaccine and 361 Anti-Rabies Vaccination was administered. Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgeries were performed on 218 animals. We had rescued 29 dogs and 4 pups and triumphed in finding forever homes for 27 of them.
2	Volunteering by Boschers	Bosch carried out its CSR activity at HAS by enabling 12 of its employees to volunteer at HAS. The new comers were briefed on the basics of rescue and first aid. The volunteers engaged themselves by making beds for our animals, grooming, deworming and bathing our furry friends.
3	Hairit by HCL	Hairit is a flagship programme by HCL which aims to conserve, restore and enhance indigenous environmental systems and respond to climate change by community engagement. For the past two years HCL has aided HAS in conducting ABC and special surgeries, administering ARV and installing snake-proof fencing.
4	Donation by Animal Aid Unlimited	Donations came through Animal Aid Unlimited, a sister organization in Udajpur. Combining it with the donation made by our Board Member-Mona Kumar, shelter's infrastructure was improved and kennels for canine patients and new cat holding area was renovated.
5	Sponsorship by Pedigree	Pedigree in collaboration with HAS, promoted the slogan 'Adopt, don't shop' by providing the parents of Indie dogs adopted from HAS with adoption kits.

1	Summary	We have treated a total of 606 animals as out-patients. 169 Multi-Component Vaccine and 437 Anti-Rabies Vaccination was administered. Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgeries were performed on 226 animals. We had rescued 38 dogs and 11 pups and triumphed in finding forever homes for 16 of them.
2	Filling the walls of HAS with colors	Volunteers from Bosch along with the very talented artist Jeevananthan collectively used their enthusiasm and creativity for engraving the walls of HAS with the pictures of our beloved residents.
3	HCL's visit to HAS	HCL, an active collaborator with HAS, sent a team to our sanctuary to explore on how their contributions were planned to be used for the welfare of the animals in the locality and beyond.

1	Summary	We have treated a total of 361 animals as out-patients. 152 Multi-Component Vaccine and 246 Anti-Rabies Vaccination was administered. Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgeries were performed on 200 animals. We had rescued 23 dogs and 9 pups and 1 kitten and also triumphed in finding forever homes for 13 of them.
2	Three-day International Dog Day	In the last weekend of the month, we celebrated a three-day International Dog Day at our sanctuary. We received an overwhelming response wherein pet lovers poured in Pedigree, rice, goodies, treats and even batches of baked dog-friendly cupcakes. HAS bows down to all volunteers and pet lovers for cheering our residents.

1	Summary	We have treated a total of 446 animals as out-patients. 149 Multi-Component Vaccine and 555 Anti-Rabies Vaccination was administered. Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgeries were performed on 159 animals. We had rescued 32 dogs and 6 pups and 1 kitten and also triumphed in finding forever homes for 16 of them.
2	One Health, Zero Deaths	HAS conducted a week long ARV drive (25th Sep-2nd Oct) and distributed pamphlets to create awareness amongst the public about the deadly Rabies. HAS extends its sincere thanks to Mr. Balakrishnan, the man behind making this ARV drive a successful one. We also extend our gratitude to Dr. Kumaravel, Dean of TANUAVAS for having given our Founder Dr. Mini Vasudevan to address and build a rapport with the young veterinary students of TANUAVAS, Udumalpet.
3	Pouring donations at HAS	The team at HAS extends its gratitude to the Rotaract Club of Vadavalli for their rice donation, to the Rotaract Spectrum for donating Whiskas, Pedigree and yummy treats and to the President of the Inner Wheel Club of Coimbatore North for donating rice and newspaper.

4	The Himalayan Vegan Fest	HAS with its delgation 'The Vegan Kada'i' and Vijay Sweets raised the Kovai Vegan Flag in the International Delegation, The Himalayan Vegan Fest. 4	Success stories of Virtual Adoptions	Ritu,Mani and Bruno are super glad in finding their virtrual parents/adopters. HAS extends its heartfelt thanks to the virtual adopters.
5	Zero tolerance against Animal Cruelty	The Peelamedu Police acted promptly to the complaint filed by HAS against the Pet shop owner Mr Dhanus Kodi for subjecting animals to cruelty in his pet shop. Four unhealthy pets which endured immense trauma and pain were rescued, treated and sterilized in HAS . This is an eye-opening incident to the public 'to adopt and not to buy' animals.

1	Summary	We have treated a total of 363 animals as out-patients. 190 Multi-Component Vaccine and 427 Anti-Rabies Vaccination was administered. Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgeries were performed on 194 animals. We had rescued 33 dogs and 3 pups and 2 kitten and also triumphed in finding forever homes for 23 of them.

1	Summary	We have treated a total of 402 animals as out-patients. 174 Multi-Component Vaccine and 355 Anti-Rabies Vaccination was administered. Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgeries were performed on 229 animals. We had rescued 37 dogs and 6 pups and also triumphed in finding forever homes for 12 of them.
2	Our selfless service in numbers	In the year 2022, the team at HAS has performed 135 special surgeris, 2393 ABC surgeries, resuced 432 pets and found pet parents for 209 of them. We have vaccinated 6210 animals and treated 3655 animals as out-patients. All of this would not have been possible without the donors, volunteers and the entire team at HAS. 1	Summary	We have treated a total of 390 animals as out-patients. 248 Multi-Component Vaccine and 343 Anti-Rabies Vaccination was administered. Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgeries were performed on 219 animals. We had rescued 36 dogs , 13 pups and 3cats and also triumphed in finding forever homes for 11 of them.
2	Visit by GRD students	25 students from GRD College visited our sanctuary as a part of their curriculum. We thank the students for having chosen to spend time with our residents.

1	Summary	We have treated a total of 332 animals as out-patients. 93 Multi-Component Vaccine and 249 Anti-Rabies Vaccination was administered. Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgeries were performed on 229 animals. We had rescued 24 dogs , 4pups and 1 kitten and also triumphed in finding forever homes for 18 of them.
2	The Animal Sensitization Voluteer Certification Program	In the tie up with Bosch, HAS offers a certification programmme on animal sensitization. This certification equips the participants with knowledge on animal welfare and skills to support the same. The first session imparted knowledge on animal welfare and role of volunteers in it. In the second session, they were taught on how to handle injured animals, giving first aid and responsibilities of pet parents and feeders. Animal Birth Control (ABC) Surgeries were performed on 227 animals. We had rescued 23 dogs , 9 pups and 1 cat and also triumphed in finding forever homes for 11 of them.
